**G 33 Desmon Farmer 6-5 210 lbs. USC**

2009-10 Averages: 23.7 ppg, 4.0 rpg, 4.7 apg, 38.0 mpg

- ♦ Scored team-season-high 41 points twice this season (1/16 at IDA, 2/19 at SPR)
- ♦ Recorded first D-League triple-double of the season (12/13 vs BAK)
- ♦ Topped 30 points 12 times this season (Bighorns are 8-4 when Farmer goes for 30+)

**F 22 Mo Charlo 6-7 210 lbs. Nevada**

## The Fast Break

**At a Glance:** Tonight, the Bighorns look to extend the first-round series with the Vipers after dropping Game 1 at home on Saturday, 110-94...marks Reno's 2nd playoff game (1st series) in franchise history...a win tonight for the 'Horns would force a deciding Game 3 on Tuesday night at Rio Grande Valley...tonight's game will be televised live on Versus.

**All-Time Series:** Tonight's titanic struggle marks the 8th all-time meeting between the Bighorns and Jonah Goldberg's Rio Grande Valley Vipers...RGV leads the all-time series 4-3...RGV has taken 4 of the 5 meetings between the 2 clubs this season...RGV has won both games played at State Farm Arena this season...RGV has held **G Desmon Farmer** to just 16.8 ppg in 5 games this season, 6.9 ppg below his regular season average.

**Playoff Picture:** This series is the only 1 of 4 first-round series that is still being played...Iowa defeated Utah 2-1, Austin defeated Dakota 2-1, and Tulsa defeated Sioux Falls 2-1 to advance to the second round...the winner of this series will play Austin, with the time and location to be determined...if the Vipers win, Game 1 of the second-round series will be played in Austin (as RGV would be the higher seed)...if the Bighorns win the series, Reno would play host to Austin in Game 1 and travel to Austin for Games 2 and 3 (if necessary).

**Boom Got Them Boards:** In Game 1 of this series, **C Rod Benson** set the Reno franchise record for rebounds in a single game...Benson grabbed 20 boards to go along with 22 points...the Cal product is the D-League's all-time leading rebounder in the regular season with 1,381...Benson also holds the record for single-game rebounds with 28 (with DAK, at SXF, 12/9/07)...his 20 rebounds in Game 1 also set a single-game D-League postseason record, breaking Lance Allred's record of 17 (with IDA, vs COL, 4/20/07).

**Gotta Get a C-Note:** Reno scored fewer than 100 points in Game 1 for just the 2nd time in its last 16 games...Reno is 12-4 during that stretch...on the season, the 'Horns are 24-14 when they score 100+ points...they are just 4-9 when failing to reach the century mark...when Reno holds opponents to fewer than 100 points, it is 15-4 on the season...when opponents break the 100-point barrier, they are 19-13 against Reno.

**What's Wrong With This Picture?** Reno and Rio Grande Valley have had vastly different relationships with the NBA this season...the Vipers have had 5 different players called-up to the NBA a record 10 times this season (Antonio Anderson; Will Conroy, 2; Mike Harris, 3; Kenny Hasbrouck; Garrett Temple, 3)...Reno has yet to have a Gatorade Call-Up to the NBA in 2 years of existence...this season, RGV has had 2 NBA assignees a total of 4 times (Jermaine Taylor, 3; Joey Dorsey, 1)...Reno has not had an NBA assignee this season.

**Biggest Little Notes in the World:** Reno is just 2-5 in games played in the Central Time Zone this season...it is also 0-3 in games played on Monday...in Game 1, only 3 Bighorns shot above 50% from the field (**Benson, Strawberry, Thomas**)...**G Desmon Farmer** attempted the most 3-pointers in the D-League during the regular season (357), while RGV's Ernest Scott shot the second-most threes (321).

**RENO, Nev.**—Despite a dominant 20-20 effort inside from Rod Benson, struggles at the foul line and beyond the three-point arc sent the Reno Bighorns to a 110-94 loss to the Rio Grande Valley Vipers in the first round of the NBA D-League Playoffs Saturday afternoon in the Reno Events Center.

With the win, Rio Grande Valley takes a 1-0 lead in the best-of-three opening round. The series will now move to Texas for games two and three, if necessary.

The Bighorns finished the day shooting 13.8 percent (4-for-29) from three-point range and 67.9 percent (36-for-53) from the foul line. Reno turned the basketball over 24 times, though the Bighorns did manage to out-rebound the Vipers 54-to-40.

The loss spoils a career-day for Benson, who recorded 22 points, 20 rebounds and two blocked shots. D.J. Strawberry added 19 points and four assists off the bench, Doug Thomas hit all five of his tries from the floor en route to 14 points, and Will Blalock dished-out seven assists.

Jonathan Wallace paced the Vipers with 22 points. Will Conroy collected 17 points and 11 assists, while Antonio Anderson recorded 19 points and 10 assists of his own.

The Bighorns led by eight points after one period of play, but from that point forward the game belonged to Rio Grande Valley. Reno trailed by just a bucket entering the final quarter of play, but the Vipers would outscore the Bighorns 29-15 in the fourth to cruise to the victory.
